

## ***Our Goals for Student Achievement***

### ***The Kindezi School Goals***

Students will demonstrate a strong and continually increasing rate of mastery over the Georgia Performance Standards.

Students will demonstrate strong and continually improving communication skills (English/Language Arts and comprehensive skills (Math) when compared to other students in the nation.

Students will demonstrate strong and continually growing breath of knowledge of the world (Social Studies) as well as strong skills at gathering information about the world as compared to others across the nation.

### ***2021-2022 Academic Year Goals***

The number of beginning level students will decrease by 50% and the number of proficient level and distinguished level students will increase by 20%.

100% of students will be able to articulate their understanding of learned concepts in clear and concise ways (accountable talk), making evident their ability to think deeply and to problem solve.

Our average MAP percentile will grow by 5% from Fall to Spring.

## ***Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success***

### **In the Classroom**

The teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in all content areas. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Offer support with resources and materials to improve comprehensive math skills and fluency in literacy.
- **Conduct home visits to encourage engagement at home**
- Our weekly and monthly newsletter that will inform all members of the community to ensure families are able to participate in school events.
- Bi weekly phone calls home to parents updating them on their individual student growth.

### **At Home**

The Kindezi School parents have been invited to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in all content areas. Families may have other ideas to add to this list:

- Attend Curriculum Night Events/Project-Based Learning showcase, and Parental University Education series.
- Utilize Parent Square and/or additional technology resources to enhance student achievement.
- Encourage reading nightly and support with homework completion.
- Visit the class and school websites to ensure we are aware of all activities at the school.

### **The Kindezi School Students**

The Kindezi School students joined with staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school and reach for goals in all content areas. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- Bring home and notices from the school when they are distributed.
- Complete homework and projects by due date assigned.
- Keep a log of books I read throughout the year.
- Share new skills learned in class with my family to support achievement.
